Students learn to lay ceramic, clay, slate, marble, glass and other types of tiles on external and internal walls and floors to provide protective and decorative finishes. Major areas of study include interpretation of plans, measurements and calculations, use of tiling tools and equipment, surface preparation and repairs.

Entry Requirements

Age Requirements

Learners must be a minimum age of 18 years or above at the time of course commencement.

Academic Requirements

Satisfactorily complete a minimum of year 10 or equivalent.

English Requirements

Applicants must provide evidence of completion of the International English Language Testing system (IELTS Test), either Academic (A) or General (G) band 6 overall, or its equivalent (refer to the list below) completed within 2 years from the application date.

Additionally, all applicants are required to:

- Having physical attributes suitable for working in the construction industry.
- A National Police check will be completed prior to attending practical placement.
- Provide documentation according to Department of Home Affairs requirements.
- Complete an LLND assessment prior to the enrolment of the course.
